The Administrative Board in January approved a proposal for some significant improvements to NOUMC's governance structure. This new structure will enable the church to plan more effectively, think and act more strategically, and operate more efficiently. This is an important element of *Our Faithful Journey*, the church's long-term vision.

It is important that the whole church understand and approve the new structure. A special Church Conference had previously been scheduled in April but was postponed due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The Special Church Conference will now be held via Zoom teleconference on Sunday, October 18, at 11:45 am. During this conference, the plan will be presented, and the church membership will be given the opportunity to discuss it and ask questions prior to voting on its adoption. #### **Sanctuary Technology Update**

Thanks to your generosity, the Technology Committee continues to do important work on updating our sanctuary technology (audio, video, live streaming). As shared previously, an initial design was discussed with the Worship Committee, after which the design was refined and communicated through requests for proposals with four potential vendors. The committee has now eliminated one of the four vendors and has received detailed plans from the others. They expect to select a final vendor within the next two weeks.

The costs proposed are somewhat higher than planned. The committee had anticipated this and expected that adjustments to the plan might be needed. The committee will be working with the selected vendor, in consultation with the Worship Committee, to determine such adjustments to the design or to phase in certain elements. This work is necessary to bring the cost in line with our budget without adversely affecting our overall goals. Once that work is completed, we will be able to provide to you an anticipated project completion date.
