Last week's winter storm led to winter weather alerts for 170 million people. The state of Texas has been hit particularly hard, resulting in power blackouts, loss of heat, and broken pipes. As the snow and ice melts, flooding will be a significant problem.

Meanwhile, the same storm system spawned tornados in the Carolinas, destroying homes.
