Sunday School Mission Project: Africa University

TEACH REACH BLESS As you may have heard, the East Ohio Conference Teach Reach Bless campaign to raise \$1.5 million to build and furnish a residence hall for female students at Africa University has met its commitment goal only one year after the campaign was launched! Although ground cannot be broken until all of the needed money has been collected, to date \$516,097.52 of committed funds have been received! The TRB campaign hopes to be able to send the full amount to Africa University in early 2022 so that construction on a new dorm that will house 90 additional female students can begin. Because of a generous challenge gift, every \$3.00 contributed will become \$4.00, so it's not too late to make a commitment or to donate! Our youth will continue to raise funds to donate to the TRB campaign until the end of May, but you can also visit the Teach Reach Bless page of the Conference website to learn more about the campaign and how you can financially support it through online or mailed in donations.

This year, we hope you will support the Sunday School Mission Project by helping us raise money to build a new dorm for female students of Africa University! Make checks payable to NOUMC, write Africa University in the memo, and send them to the office, attention Wendy Cooper.



2020 Financial Report

For all of 2020, we received \$218,769 in offerings. We also received \$2,002 in rent, proceeds from the Dover Players, and Amazon Smile rebates, for a total of \$220,771. Thank you all for your support, especially those members of the congregation who have paid ahead or paid all of their 2020 pledge. The church's expenses for the year totaled \$255,025, which results in a shortfall of \$34,254. We have been able to pay all of our bills, our apportionments, and our payroll on time.

Here is the breakdown of our expenses for 2020:

UMW FUNDrive: Weekend of May 23; actual dates and times TBA


We will have a trailer in the parking lot to collect your rummage sale-type items.
